DPD MEMBERS DONATE OVER 800 FREE BIKE LICENSES

DETROIT- Police Chief Ella M. Bully-Cummings along with the Detroit Police Department's executive team, the three police unions, and the Detroit Firefighters Association have come together to provide a special gift to the children of Detroit. *On Saturday, July 12, 2008, from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.,* more than 800 FREE bicycle licenses will be available for children 15 and under (first come, first served) at various locations citywide. To take part, parents can register their child's bicycle at their nearest Police District Station. Each District Station will have at least 100 free bicycle licenses to give away. Bicycles being registered must be on site. In addition to the six Police Districts, 100 free licenses will also be available to children 15 and under at two separate locations: the North Rosedale Park Community House and the Butzel Family Recreation Center.

"We want to have as many bicycles registered in the city of Detroit as possible," said Chief Bully-Cummings who is personally donating 50 licenses. "Especially those that belong to children. The licenses assist our officers in identifying stolen bicycles and greatly increase the chance of a bicycle being returned back to its owner if it is ever stolen and recovered." Chief Bully-Cummings continued, "Now is also a perfect time for residents to inventory their home valuables and label them if possible. This type of documentation always aids our officers during an investigation of stolen property and has led to many arrests."

Due to city charter requirements, the Detroit Police Department cannot waive the \$1.00 bicycle fee, so members of the Detroit Police Department donated the funds that will cover the cost of the licenses during the giveaway.

Five local bicycle stores have also partnered up with the Detroit Police Department to offer FREE bicycle inspections and 10% discounts on bicycle safety equipment for individuals who bring in proof of Detroit bicycle registration.
